### PANACUR DEWORMING REGIMEN FOR DOGS AND CATS

Benefits: Panacur acts as an immune system stimulant (by stimulating the bone marrow); it is antifungal as well as a gut astringent. It is a very effective treatment for ulcers of the esophagus, stomach, and gut. It can also facilitate the penetration of antibiotics and white blood cells into resistant toxic scars and chronically infected tissue, helping them to resolve.

What: Treat the dog or cat with a dose of Panacur (fenbendazole 10%, 100mg/g) at a rate of 1g per 10 lbs. per day for 3 days. Then repeat this 3-day protocol two weeks later. The powder can be mixed with wet food, yogurt, or by adding water and dosing directly, or mixing this solution with dry food.

When: Given at least twice a year. Can be given each month for 3 days for persistent problems.

Indications: For the control of roundworms, hookworms, whipworms and some types of tapeworms. Panacur is particularly effective against Giardia, chronic low-grade *Candida* (yeast) and many fungal infections, both localized (toenails and ears) and systemic (skin/gut “allergies” and other syndromes.)

Side Effects: A *very small* percentage of animals may have vomiting and nausea. If the animal is infested with worms or has a significant *Candida* infection, diarrhea may occur, but this is rare.
